





The main functions of the Equal Opportunity Cell would be:

- To ensure equity and equal opportunity to the community at large in the college.
- To enhance the diversity among the students, teaching and non-teaching staff and at the same time eliminate the perceptions of discrimination.
- To create a socially congenial atmosphere for academic interaction and for the growth of healthy interpersonal relationships among the students coming from different social backgrounds.
- To make efforts to sensitize the academic community regarding the problems associated with social exclusion as well as the aspirations of the marginalized communities.
- To look into the grievances of the weaker sections of the society and suggest amicable solutions to their problems.
- To facilitate barrier free formalities / procedures for admissions / registrations of students belonging to the disadvantaged group of society.
- To organize periodic meeting to monitor the progress of different schemes.
- To sensitize the college on the problems of SC/ST and other disadvantaged groups.





Since this was the first meeting, the members were apprised of the many schemes and functions by the Member Secretary.
