












BANGALORE CITY COLLEGE.

✓ 1. NAAC REPORT:

It was reported to the members that the NAAC Team visited our College and were satisfied with the facilities, faculties and the

infrastructure of the College. We ~~was~~ were awarded with "B" Grade with CGPA 2.66 points with effect from 24.09.2014. This accreditation will be valid upto 23.09.2019. The previous CGPA points awarded by the previous NAAC in 2009 were 2.32. This time there was an increase in CGPA from 2.32 to 2.66.

2. ADMISSION FOR THE NEXT ACADEMIC YEAR:

It was reported that the Management is taking all necessary steps for increasing the number of admissions for the next year. A team of marketing persons are visiting all institutions, meeting the Principal/students and giving presentation in institutions, meeting the students and distributing leaflets.

3. APPOINTMENT OF NEW FACULTIES:

The Chairman reported that the faculties were appointed in the department where there was a shortage of staff.

4. LIC OBSERVATION:

As per the requirement of the LIC report, the following measures were taken.

1. Books and Journals worth Rs. 2 lacs were purchased.
2. Eligible teachers participated in the extension field work visiting NGO's and NSS Camps.
3. Eligible teachers were sent for evaluation work for both UG & PG.

4. Most of the teachers have attended FDP seminars and workshops.
5. Now the College has 4 teachers with NET Qualification
11 with M.Phil and 15 ph.D. holders
6. The overall percentage of result has improved.

5. NATIONAL CONFERENCE:

Proposed A national Conference is jointly conducted by the Computer and Management Departments. ^{expecting} Many participants from various Colleges took part and presented papers. Hospitality should be provided to all the participants.
